A blend of Mataro 74% & Grenache 26%, the Salsa is primed and ready to dance across your lips with fresh red forest berry fruits ...raspberries and hawthorn and an intriguing spice line which includes star anise with hints of pepper and cardamom. Crunchy red fruits flow across the palate, held in check by balanced acidity and kept long and dry with chalky fine phenolics.

Vibrant aromas of lemon-citrus, and ripe Rockmelon, surrounded by subtle notes of vanilla and toasted oak. It offers crisp acidity with flavours of citrus, stone fruits (Peach), balanced by a creamy texture plus hints of butterscotch. The finish is clean and refreshing with a touch of minerality. On the palate, this wine can be described as mid-to full bodied for a white wine.
